Profilo breve

Paolo Forlin è docente di archeologia medievale all'Università degli Studi di Bologna, dove attualmente tiene gli insegnamenti di 'Insediamenti e sistemi abitativi medievali' e 'Archaeology of disasters, climate change and resilience'.

Paolo si occupa di archeologia del paesaggio e lavora in particolare sull'archeologia dei disastri, con un focus su terremoti, frane e alluvioni dell'Europa medievale.

Dopo essersi formato in Italia all'Università di Padova e Trento, Paolo ha lavorato come ricercatore in Francia (Université de Franche-Comté), Inghilterra (Durham University) e negli USA (Northwestern University a Chicago).

Ha condotto e coordinato scavi in Italia e all'estero, in particolare Inghilterra, Spagna, Azzorre (Portogallo), Francia e Nepal.

Attualmente dirige il progetto Archeo San Donato sui paesaggi archeologici di San Donato di Lamon e lo scavo sulla frana medievale del Mont Granier in Francia (la più grande frana di epoca storica in Europa). Partecipa anche al progetto 'Cervia Vecchia' in Romagna, dove sta indagando la rocca di Cervia Vecchia, una città abbandonata alla fine del Seicento.

Nel 2024 ha pubblicato 'The medieval Alps. Landscape, people and power in eastern Trentino', una ricerca di archeologia dei paesaggi sulla Valsugana e Val di Cembra nel medioevo frutto del dottorato di ricerca conseguito presso l'università di Trento.
